EGM RESULTS

Last Friday (30th September), we held an Extraordinary General Meeting where members voted on proposed amendments to our constitution. As a result, we are pleased to announce that we will be introducing the roles of Welsh Officer, Events Officer (Social), and Events Officer (Upskill) to our committee. *Fluency in written and spoken Welsh is a requirement.
- **Events Officer (Social)** - Responsible for organising and hosting socials over the course of the academic year to facilitate networking and encourage members to enjoy themselves.
- **Events Officer (Upskill)** - Responsible for organising and where possible hosting career-focused events, workshops, and informative social mobility-centric events with the aim of upskilling our member base.

- **Welfare and Equalities Officer** - Responsible for diversity, inclusion, and enhanced experience of underrepresented members, advancing equality and diversity, addressing welfare issues of club members, and increasing widening participation.
