We hope you are all looking forward to the month ahead. There are some important deadlines fast approaching so please see the final reminders below:

#### Freshers Fairs – click here to request a stall!!!

As stated in the last two committee updates, the freshers' fairs will take place 25th – 28th of September. The Societies and Volunteering days will be Wednesday 27th September and Thursday 28th September at Cathays and Wednesday 27th September at Heath Park.

If you would like to have a stall at any of the Freshers Fairs days, you must complete <u>this form</u> by **9am Monday 4th September.** Failure to complete the form on time will result in your society not having a stall at the Freshers fairs. You will receive stall confirmation shortly after the deadline.

# **Regular Room Bookings**

If your group requires a regular room booking in the Student's Union, please complete the request form <a href="here">here</a> by Monday 4th September 9am if you have not already done so.

You can request room bookings for society activity in university buildings through the <u>resource booker</u> (the same one to book library rooms). Presidents and secretaries should have access to the 'student's union/society bookings' option. Please note that the university are still finalising lecture timetables so check back to book anything after 2<sup>nd</sup> October.

#### **Guild of Societies Memberships**

Guild memberships are now on sale! You should have all received an email on 23<sup>rd</sup> August to announce that they were on sale and are now priced at £8 for the year.

Please make sure that you buy your guild **and** society membership by **Monday 30<sup>th</sup> October** to continue your committee membership. You are required to purchase a membership; you do not automatically gain one when you are elected.
