Committee Training Information

Please ensure you have completed your online committee training by Monday 25th September and attend the in-person training sessions if you or your other committee members have not already done so. You can find the committee training schedule attached to the 1st August update email and is also attached to this email. Each club and society are required to send at least one person to each session.

There is a session titled Socials and Conducts Guild of Societies at 2.30pm on Thursday 21st September. This is the only time this session is run and is especially important for all presidents and social secretaries to attend if able. If they are unable to attend, please send a suitable replacement member from the committee. If no one on committee can make this session, please let us know.

You do not have to attend repeat sessions over the two weeks, please just attend one of each session! If you attended the training back in May these are repeats of those sessions so you do not need to attend if your society has already sent at least one person to each of those sessions.

We are aware that there are strikes happening whilst we are doing our training sessions, please be mindful of this when choosing which sessions to attend. The UCU have not requested that we change the venue or cancel these sessions within university buildings.

Wellbeing Officer Training

Every society should have a Wellbeing Officer, or someone within your committee that takes on the responsibility of a wellbeing officer. (Our suggestion for this person would be your President or Social Secretary if you do not have a Wellbeing officer). As you would have seen in our Welcome email on the 1st of August, we have 6 sessions of Wellbeing Officer training. These sessions are all the same so you only need to attend one, but places on these are limited so you must book on to the session you would like to attend. Grant Application Information

All Societies are welcome to apply for grant funding from the Students Union. You can read more about the Grant Funding Application policy attached to the last update email (update #4), to apply for grant funding please complete this <u>form</u>. The deadline to complete this form is 09:00am on Monday 8th October. We often must reject requests purely due to lack of detail on the application, so please include as much information as possible.

Societies and Volunteering Executive Committees

Applications for Societies and Volunteering Executive Committees are now open! Each Sabbatical Officer has at least one executive committee which is designed to shape and support the work of the elected officers. This could include supporting them in the development of policy, running outreach activity, or simply putting on events and activities students want to see. The Societies Executive Committee has 25 members, 18 elected through a cross-campus ballot and seven representatives selected with approval of the societies forum amongst society committee members - with each one representing one of the seven categories of students' union societies. All members of the Societies Executive Committee must be members of the Guild of Societies. The Volunteering Executive Committee has 10 members, six elected through a cross-campus ballot and four selected with approval of the appropriate forum. All members of the Volunteering Executive Committee must be a member of a volunteering project or R.A.G groups. As mention above, there are two ways to successfully be appointed to the Societies and Volunteering Executive Committees. You can either opt to run in the Autumn Election process and be elected via cross campus ballot, or apply via the selection process where you will be interviewed by a panel including the Vice President Societies and Volunteering. Successful candidates will then be approved by the relevant forum
