Venues Accessibility Procedure - Events

- All of our venues are accessible and suitable for disabled customers wherever practicable

DISABLED ACCESS

Accessible Parking

Please note that unfortunately Cardiff University Students' Union does not offer any customer parking. There is substantial 'pay and display' on road parking available directly in front of both the Park Place and Senghennydd Road entrances respectively.

Please note that parking availability may be limited during the daytime (09:00 - 18:00 Mon - Fri)

Venue Access

The Students' Union front entrance is on Park Place, there is a ground level lift positioned behind the stairs at the main entrance which provides access to the main reception on Level 2. A lift is available inside the building for access to all other levels. The rear entrance is on Senghennydd Road. Please be aware that there are two entrances at this location. The door between 'Magic Wrap' and 'Cardiff Student Letting' is on a flat level with a lift available off the central stairwell of the building giving access to all other levels.

Hearing Assistance

Both Reception and on site event security / stewarding staff in our venues will assist in your enquiries as required.

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Assistance Dogs

All assistance dogs are welcome. Venue staff should be approached for further information. It is however not recommended that animals be subjected to the loud noises and special effects from concerts. The venue should be contacted directly should you have concerns or special requirements.

Toilets and Cloakrooms

Toilets facilities are available on the all floors except ground level. Dedicated disabled toilets are on levels 2 – 4 and are all unisex.

Box Office Events

There is space provided for wheelchair users with one accompanying person permitted per wheelchair. We endeavour to accommodate other special needs visitors if possible at all live music events. Please notify the venues team **(029 2078 1457** or e-mail **BoxOffice@Cardiff.ac.uk)** when booking your tickets if you have any special needs.

First Aid/Medical Assistance

Special medical requirements or concerns should be notified to the venue prior to arrival. This will allow us to provide you with the required level of medical care. For all events, qualified staff and facilities are available.

Taxi Booking

Accessible taxis can be booked through Capital Cabs (029 2077 7777). The venue should be contacted if a taxi has been pre-booked and you require assistance.

Restaurants and Bars

Please ask a member of staff for assistance. Large print menus are available on request. Any special requirements should be directed to the venue prior to arrival.

Help and Assistance

Should you require any information prior to your arrival, please contact the Switchboard on 029 2078 1400. Should you experience any problems while at our venues, please contact any member of staff and ask for a member of the Duty Management team who will assist you as necessary.

For disabled customers attending events within the venues we can offer a complimentary carer ticket when requested in advance – subject to availability and capacity. (Please note that whilst we strive to accommodate all requests this policy cannot override the agreed safe capacity limits that are set for our events)
