Libraries Update

Arrangements for the Christmas Vacation and January Exam Period.

Cardiff University library books will not be due for return or be recalled between Saturday 15 December and Monday 7 January.

Books can be requested throughout the vacation and examination period and the usual loan and renewal periods will resume on 7 January. Check your University email for recall notices and be prepared to return any recalled items by their due date. If you're away from Cardiff, post items back to us to avoid fines. Alternatively, check LibrarySearch for eBook versions to save carrying heavy textbooks home.

2. Borrowing limit raised to 35 items.

All undergraduate and taught post grad students may now borrow up to 35 items at a time. A reminder that if the book(s) you need are on loan, and there are no more copies on the shelf, you'll need to place a request to ensure that you see a copy of the book.

Opening hours for all libraries are available on our web pages. ASSL and the Health Library are open a 24/7, and this will continue throughout the Christmas Closure period, make sure you have your ID card to gain access.
