

2015 Postgraduate Taught Experience Survey summary report for the College of Biomedical and Life Sciences n=827 (44.0% response rate)



The Postgraduate Taught Experience Survey (PTES) is a national online survey that looks at seven thematic areas: the quality of teaching and learning, engagement, assessment and feedback, dissertation, organisation and management, learning resources, and skills development. The survey also provides the opportunity to ask additional questions about some of the services and facilities specific to Cardiff University that are provided for postgraduate students.
