
Study @ Cardiff 2015 Survey Dashboard - CHEMY

The Study@Cardiff survey is designed to assess the satisfaction of current undergraduate students who are not in their first or final years of study. It allows students the opportunity to give opinions on their University experience, which can then be acted upon whilst they are still studying here. The survey focuses on the areas of assessment & feedback and organisation & management, as well as giving students the opportunity to comment on any particularly positive or negative experiences that they may wish to highlight.
