

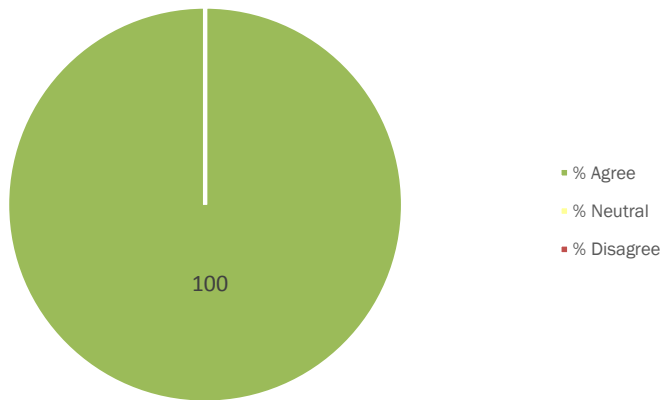
Study @ Cardiff 2015 Survey Dashboard - MUSIC

n=18 (24% response rate)

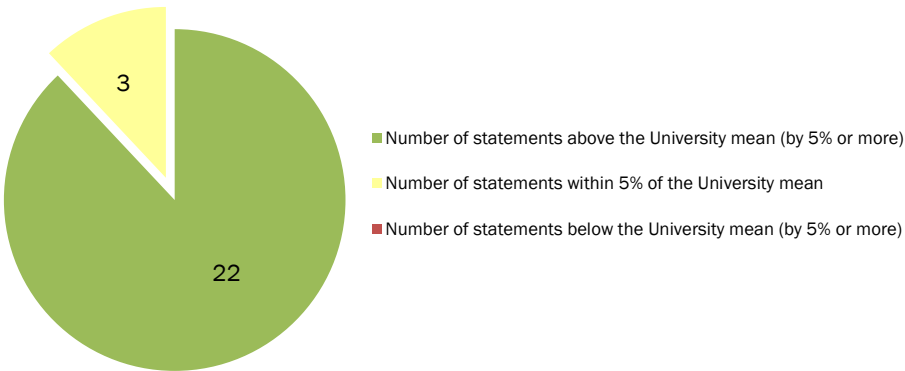
